Information Needed to Sign Up for Sports

****All registration information can be found on the HS Homepage,
under athletics tab****

Every year/season student athletes are required to complete 6 steps in order to be eligible for sports:

1. Pass in a valid physical
 2. Sign electronic Athletic Handbook Acknowledgement Form (**sign 1x a year**)
 3. NFHS Concussion Certificate (**Certificate only need to be passed in 1x a school year**)
 4. Required Registration/Concussion Form. (**Form only need to be filled out once a school year**)
 5. User Fee (**paid each season**)
 6. ImPact Baseline Concussion Test (**completed once every 2 years, AD will inform students when their appointment is to take this test, must be completed in school**)

1. Pass in valid physical (Valid for 13 months) to Athletic Director. If nurse has on file, please provide AD with physical date.
2. The Athletic Handbook is located under “Announcements” on the athletic homepage. Athletes and Parent/Guardians must read the handbook, then sign off on the acknowledgement page.

3. The NFHS Concussion course will take approximately 45 mins. to complete. Once you have finished please print or email the certificate to the athletic director.
4. The required registration/concussion form needs to be filled out with a parent/guardian and once completed will automatically get emailed directly to the athletic director.
5. The user fee can either be paid online by credit card or by bank check or money order, made payable to WINTHROP PUBLIC SCHOOLS. Personal checks will not be accepted.
6. The ImPact Baseline test will be completed in the HS computer Lab or on the students Chromebook. During the 1st week of the season each coach will be handed a list of students required to take the test, along with a date and time for the athletes to complete it.
